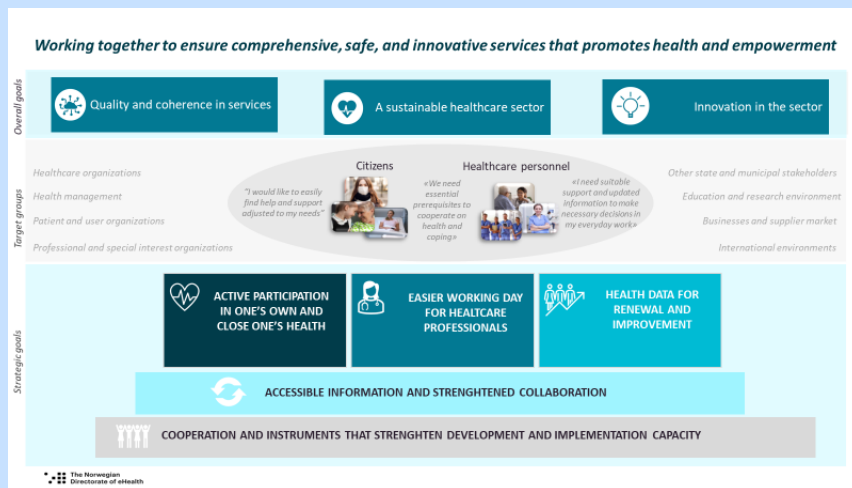

Overall direction and five strategic goals



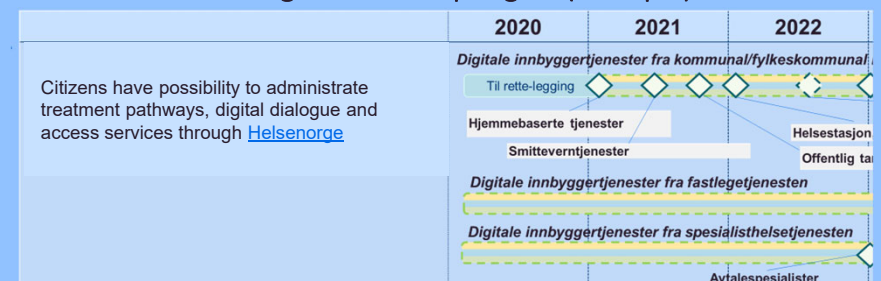
Plan for realization of the strategy, yearly

The action plan shows target indicators and strategic initiatives for the five goals. This will change over time, and the action plan will therefore be dynamic/adjusted to take into account changes in what is measured and implemented. The document also describes how the strategic follow-up will take place

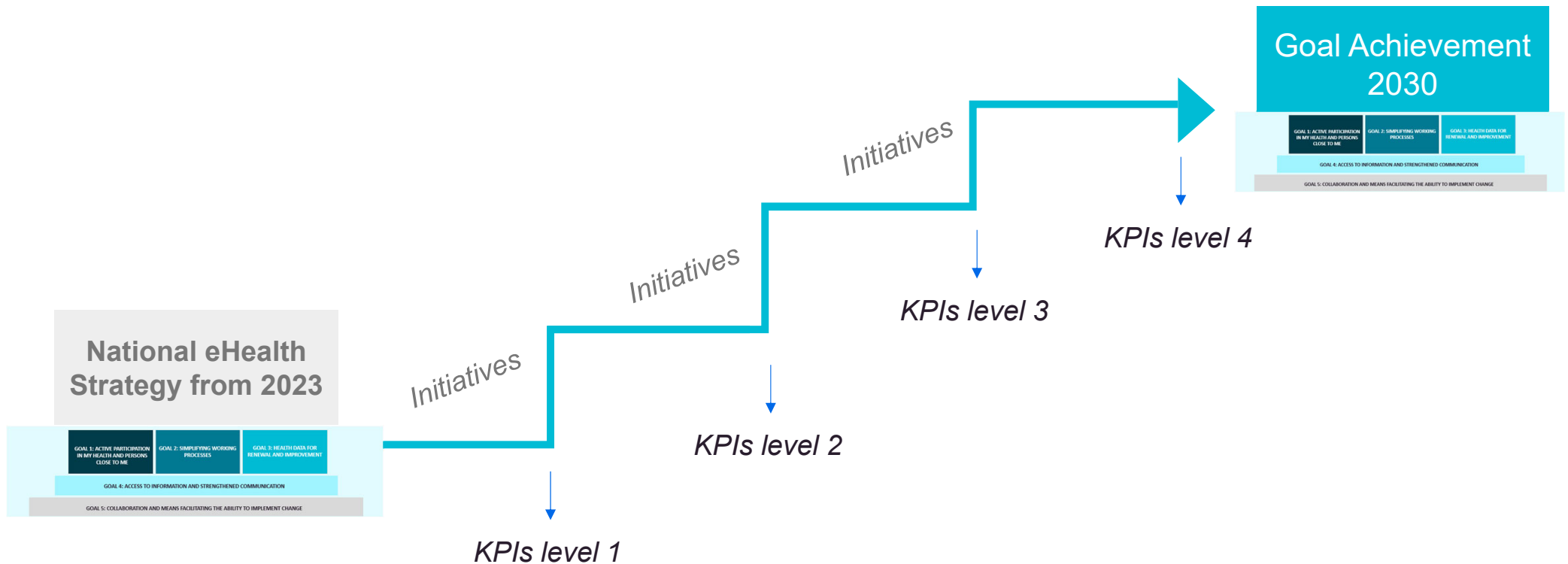
Target indicators per measure (example)
